Safety Instructions:

- The box is not suitable for the transport of hazardous substances.
- Observe maximum load: no more than 15 kg per Euro Box to avoid damage or injury.
- Slipping or tipping over may occur on slippery and smooth surfaces; store and stack safely.
- Protect from extreme temperatures below -20 °C or above +100 °C as well as direct sunlight to avoid material damage or deformation.
- When used in automated handling and on conveyor lines, ensure compatibility, correct use and safe loading.
- Not suitable for use with open flames, extreme heat sources or contact with hot surfaces.
- Keep out of reach of children to prevent accidental play or swallowing of small parts.
- The box is not suitable for contact with food or aggressive chemicals unless they have been specifically tested or protected for this purpose.
- Remove sharp or pointed objects before transport to avoid injury.
- Check regularly for visible damage.
- Only suitable for manual transport of goods in accordance with the specified load capacity of up to 15 kg.
- The Euro Box should not be used near direct heat sources.
- The boxes must not be used for hot liquids.
- Before cleaning, select suitable cleaning agents that are suitable for polypropylene.
- The product is resistant to most oils, acids and alkalis, but check specific chemicals before use.
- Store the product out of the reach of children to avoid possible hazards.
- When handling the Euro Box, underhand grips should be used to minimise the risk of injury.
