Safety Instructions:

- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to the risk of choking on small parts.
- Maximum operating temperature: +70 degrees Celsius; minimum operating temperature: -40 degrees Celsius.
- Suitable for the storage and transport of unpackaged foodstuffs. Do not use for the storage of chemicals or hazardous substances.
- Avoid excessive loads to ensure the stability of the box.
- Protect from direct sunlight to avoid material deformation and discolouration.
- Ensure that the box is stable when stacked to prevent it from tipping over.
- Not suitable for contact with frozen food below -40 degrees Celsius.
- Do not use the box in the microwave or oven.
- Check regularly for damage, cracks or severe deformation to ensure safety and food safety.
- Use food-safe materials and ensure that the box is clean before it comes into contact with food.
- Do not handle with sharp or pointed objects to avoid damage.
- Disposal in accordance with local regulations for recycling and waste management.
- Use the label holders supplied to label contents to ensure traceability.
- Use the box only for its intended purpose, suitable for the storage, transport and presentation of unpackaged food.
- Do not use in areas where chemical substances could affect the integrity of the material.
- Ensure that the box is not overloaded to prevent breakage or deformation.
