Safety Instructions:

- Use the storage level according to the manufacturer's specific instructions.
- Ensure that only authorised hazardous substances are stored on the storage level.
- Store and handle safely: Only use the storage level for storing hazardous substances in accordance with the applicable regulations.
- Wear personal protective equipment (PPE): Suitable protective measures such as protective gloves and goggles are required when handling and storing hazardous substances.
- Avoid direct skin contact with hazardous substances.
- Keep the work area clean and tidy to minimise risks.
- Find out about the specific hazards of the substances stored at the storage level.
- Ensure that the storage level is stable and properly mounted to prevent accidents such as tipping over.
- Do not store near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Ensure adequate ventilation. The storage level is only suitable for use in closed and well-ventilated areas.
- A risk analysis should be carried out before use to ensure the safety of employees.
- The product may contain sharp-edged parts; therefore caution is advised.
- When storing materials containing hazardous substances, the regulations on the storage of hazardous substances must be observed.
- Check regularly for damage: Ensure that the storage level has no visible damage that could impair safety.
- Consult safety data sheets (SDS): Safety data sheets must be observed and made available.
- Dispose of hazardous waste in accordance with local regulations.
- In the event of a spill, take immediate action to contain and clean up.
- Additional safety measures: Depending on the hazardous substance stored, ventilation or special storage units may be required.
