Safety Instructions:

- Do not use the product if overloaded, observe maximum 100 kg.
- Do not exceed the maximum recommended load of 100 kg.
- Shelving is only intended for the storage of lightweight items. Avoid overloading.
- Ensure that shelves are mounted stably, especially in cold storage or deep-freeze rooms.
- Watch out for sharp edges on the stainless steel parts during installation, risk of injury.
- Check shelves regularly for rust and damage to ensure safe use.
- Do not store heavy objects on the upper shelves to avoid the risk of tipping over.
- Carefully read and follow the safety information and installation instructions.
- Stabilise rows of shelves with diagonal braces to prevent them from tipping over.
- During assembly, ensure that the shelves are properly secured to the wall to prevent them from wobbling.
- To ensure the safety of the shelving structure, only use accessories that have been approved by us.
- Do not place shelves near heat sources to avoid damaging the material.
- Carry out regular inspections of the shelving structure and fixings to ensure safety.
- Ensure that the product fulfils the requirements of general product safety.
- Include clear instructions and safety information in understandable language.
- Observe safety measures for the stability of the rows of shelves and use diagonal crosses.
- Fasten the shelf correctly to prevent it from toppling over.
