Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the barrier post is stable to prevent it from toppling over, especially in autumn or winter when there is snow or ice.
- Do not overload the webbing and check it regularly for damage to prevent it from tearing. Excessive tension and use over the maximum length should be avoided.
- Take care when handling the heavy post (15 kg) - note the risk of injury when lifting.
- Do not store near sources of high heat or chemicals to avoid material damage.
- The barrier post is not a toy; children should be kept away from its use. Do not use in areas where children play.
- Avoid use in extreme weather conditions such as strong winds; secure or remove the post in such conditions.
- The product should only be used in the intended area of application in order to avoid injuries due to improper use.
- It is necessary to provide clear instructions in the local language on how to use and maintain the product.
- Remove the barrier post in the event of short-term and heavy public traffic in order to minimise the risk of accidents.
- Check and avoid sharp edges on the metal post and loose parts of the webbing for risk of injury and suffocation.
- Do not position near doors or driveways to minimise the risk of accidents.
