Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the stacking box is not overloaded to prevent it from tipping or falling over.
- Do not use harsh cleaning agents when cleaning to prevent damage to the material.
- Warning: Not suitable for contact with food.
- Ensure adequate ventilation when stacking to prevent overheating.
- Ensure correct positioning of crates near machines or on conveyor systems to prevent slippage.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to choking hazard from small parts.
- Do not use extreme temperatures below -20°C or above +100°C to avoid damaging the material.
- Ensure correct handling to prevent tipping and structural damage.
- Only use the stacking box for its intended purpose; improper use can lead to damage.
- Use the product with care in environments with aggressive chemicals, as there are risks despite its insensitivity to most acids and alkalis.
- Ensure that the stacking box does not tip over in the event of improper handling.
- Avoid contact with sharp objects to prevent damage.
- Protect from direct sunlight to avoid discolouration or deformation.
- Ensure ventilation in closed rooms to prevent material problems caused by high temperatures.
- Ensure that the product is out of the reach of children to avoid potential hazards.
- Check for visible damage before use, do not use if cracked or damaged.
- Take precautions for safety measures during internal transport and storage.
