Safety Instructions:

- The crates must not be loaded with more than 600 kg to ensure stability and safety.
- Crates should be used on stable surfaces to prevent tipping or sliding.
- Pay attention to extreme temperatures when using outdoors. Observe temperature stability between -20°C and +100°C.
- Protect from direct sunlight and extreme heat, as polypropylene can melt at over 100°C.
- The boxes are resistant to many oils, acids and alkalis, but contact with aggressive chemicals should be avoided.
- The crates are not suitable for food unless they are certified as food-safe.
- Check regularly for cracks or damage to avoid safety risks.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years due to choking hazard from small parts.
- Use in accordance with the instructions for use to avoid injury and material damage.
- The box should not be used as a seat to avoid the risk of injury.
- The box can tip over if stacked improperly, follow the recommended stacking guidelines.
- Do not use near open flames as materials are flammable.
- Ensure safe handling when lifting and carrying, especially with full or heavy boxes.
- Only use suitable cleaning agents for cleaning to avoid material damage.
- Use outside the recommended temperature limits can cause material damage.
