Safety Instructions:

- Appropriate storage is necessary to maintain the quality of the sandpaper, protect from moisture.
- Do not use near naked flames to avoid the risk of fire.
- Ensure that the sandpaper is only used with the intended materials to prevent risks such as overheating.
- Avoid using on wet or damp surfaces so as not to impair the material properties.
- Ensure that suitable protective equipment is worn (e.g. respirator mask, safety goggles), especially when working with paints and metals.
- Observe the manufacturer's data sheets and safety information.
- Avoid high temperatures during sanding to reduce the risk of fire.
- Take breaks during prolonged use to prevent overexertion.
