Safety Instructions:

- Remove the drill from the power source when it is not in use.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment (safety goggles, hearing protection, protective gloves) to avoid injury.

- The tool should not be used near water sources or in damp conditions to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- Use only by adults or under their supervision to prevent misuse and injury.
- Dispose of old drill bits in accordance with local regulations.
- Suitable respiratory protection is recommended, especially when working in dusty environments.
- Keep hands and hair away from the drilling site to avoid injury.
- Wear protective clothing to protect skin and clothing from injuries caused by chips and dust.
