

Product Safety Information

Deep Clamping Screw Clamp TGNT Clamping W.800mm A.300mm Wooden Handle 45x12mm

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Please note the technical data of the products!

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Safety Instructions:

- High voltage during use can lead to dangerous situations.
- Only use the clamp for the intended materials and applications to avoid injury.
- Wear safety and protective goggles or eye protection to prevent injuries caused by abrasion, splinters or slipping of the workpiece.
- Ensure that the clamp is used on a stable and level surface to prevent it from wobbling and falling over.
- Before use, check the integrity of the clamp and ensure that it is properly installed to avoid unexpected failure.
- Caution: High clamping forces up to 7000 N; caution with improper use due to risk of injury or crushing.
- Risk of injury due to movements of the clamping device or high clamping forces during use.
- Follow the safety instructions, especially when tightening and loosening the screw; do not exceed the maximum clamping force of 7000 N.
- Avoid contact with moving parts and pay attention to parts away from the body when clamping to prevent injuries.
- For adult use only or under adult supervision; not suitable for children, keep away from children.
- Proper storage and handling required to avoid accidents or back injuries due to the weight of the product (6.7 kg).
- Risk of suffocation due to improper handling; ensure correct use and safety.
- Sharp edges or clamping brackets can pose a risk of injury; wearing protective gloves is recommended.
- Take care not to exceed the maximum weight capacity of 3.41 kg to avoid breakage.
- Keep the wooden handle dry and clean to minimise the risk of slipping and prevent breakages.
- Do not use the product if it is damaged or defective.
- Do not use or store in the vicinity of children; observe packaging and instructions for use.
