Safety Instructions:

- Caution: Risk of falling when working at heights, especially above 2 to 2.5 metres. Safety measures are essential.
- Be aware of the risk of suffocation due to improper handling or assembly of small parts and accessories of the mobile scaffold.
- Make sure that the mobile scaffold tower is standing on a stable, level and firm surface.
- load must not exceed the maximum permissible load capacity of 200 kg/m².
- Only trained persons should use the scaffolding.
- Use the Guard-Matic system to ensure fall protection and always mount it properly.
- Slip-resistant rungs and decking platforms must be checked and used to minimise the risk of falling.
- Suitable personal protective equipment such as helmets and non-slip shoes are required.
- Check for stability and correct fixation (especially 6-point fixation) before use and before assembly.
- Do not use in windy or bad weather conditions.
- Ensure a safe distance from electrical cables to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- The castors must be correctly braked to prevent the scaffolding from rolling away.
- Regular checks for the stability and secured assembly of all components are essential before use.
- Observe safety precautions in accordance with the applicable regulations and standards, especially above a working height of 6.3 metres.
- When used at great heights, stabilisers and all safety frames should be attached in accordance with the instructions.
- The work area should be free of obstacles to avoid tripping hazards.
- Do not leave the scaffolding unattended without having taken safety measures.
- The instructions for use and all installation instructions should always be followed.
