Safety Instructions:

- All safety information should be provided in an understandable language.
- The locker may only be used for its intended purpose, specifically for the storage of firefighting equipment.
- Regular checks for damage and wear to the spindle are necessary, especially on moving parts, in order to minimise safety risks.
- Ensure that the locker is stable and properly installed to prevent it from tipping over or falling.
- The locker should be placed on a stable, level surface and should not be overloaded to ensure its stability and safety.
- Ventilation openings must be kept free of blockages to ensure proper air circulation and prevent mould growth.
- Sharp edges or parts must be avoided to prevent injuries.
- The load-bearing capacity of the shelf and the coat rail must not be exceeded in order to avoid breakage or warping.
- Installation should be carried out by qualified personnel in accordance with the safety and installation instructions.
- All equipment should be fitted and stowed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions in order to avoid accidents.
- The locker should not be installed near heat sources or in areas of high humidity to prevent material damage.
- Corrosion resistance is given, but contact with aggressive chemicals and cleaning agents should be avoided.
- Direct sunlight should be avoided to prolong the life of the material.
- Users should be informed about safe use and possible hazards.
