Safety Instructions:

- Use only for the storage of firefighting and protective equipment.
- Sharp edges can cause injuries. Avoid collisions with the locker.
- Keep the locker dry to prevent corrosion or damage.
- The locker is not suitable for children.
- Regularly check the function and cleanliness of the ventilation openings to ensure proper air circulation.
- Ensure a stable installation to prevent the appliance from tipping over.
- The ventilation openings must not be blocked to prevent mould growth.
- Avoid knocks or impacts that could damage the structure.
- When installing, follow the user instructions carefully and install on a firm, level surface.
- Intended for commercial use only.
- Ensure that the product is used in accordance with the operating instructions.
- Do not store excessive weights on the hook rails or hanging inside.
- Check the cylinder locks regularly for functionality to prevent theft.
- Children must be supervised at all times to minimise the risk of accidents.
- Avoid direct sunlight to prevent material damage.
- Only use acid-free cleaning agents to avoid damaging the surface coating.
- The locker is not suitable for storing food.
- Ensure regular maintenance in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Only use the keys supplied for the cylinder lock and keep them in a safe place.
- If parts are damaged, take immediate action to repair or replace them to ensure safety.
- Do not use as a seat.
- Avoid the risk of slipping with wet equipment.
- Regularly check the locker for damage or wear to minimise safety risks.
- Ensure ventilation to prevent mould formation due to moisture.
- Do not place the firefighter's locker near a source of fire.
