Safety Instructions:

- Regularly check for damage or wear to the locker, especially the steel structure, hinges and locks, to ensure safety.
- Make sure that the locker is in a stable position to prevent it from tipping over. If necessary, secure it to the wall.
- Ensure that all parts are correctly fitted and properly secured to avoid injury.
- Ventilation openings must be kept clear to prevent mould growth and overheating.
- Avoid injuries: Beware of sharp edges on the steel body and when opening and closing the doors.
- Keep out of reach of children to prevent injury from improper use or small parts.
- Ensure that the locker is not used as a toy; not suitable for children under 3 years of age.
- Ensure that no excessive loads can be exerted on the locker or the doors; observe the recommended maximum load.
- Avoid using aggressive cleaning agents that could damage the coating; only use recommended cleaning agents.
- Avoid storing flammable or hazardous substances in the locker.
- Ensure that all lock mechanisms function properly to prevent theft and unauthorised access.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for use carefully and use only for the intended purpose.
- Do not install the product in damp or extreme environments to avoid corrosion damage.
- If used incorrectly, there is a risk of injury, particularly from clothing and helmet holders.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment when handling heavy parts or during assembly.
- Ensure that valuables are stored safely; no liability for loss or theft.
- Children should not have unsupervised access to lockers, especially those containing small items.
- Install the screws and fastening systems correctly and check them regularly.
