Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the battery charging cabinet is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Access to electrical components only for qualified personnel.
- Do not allow any liquids to enter the electrical appliances to avoid the risk of electric shock and short circuits.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of the drawers (50 kg).
- Keep the product out of the reach of children to avoid the risk of suffocation and improper use.
- Read the operating instructions and safety information before use and always keep them to hand.
- Only use the cabinet in dry, well-ventilated areas and protect it from direct sunlight.
- Stow cables and power supply units safely to avoid tripping hazards.
- Only use original spare parts to ensure the safety and functionality of the product.
- Do not handle acrylic glass viewing windows with sharp objects to avoid the risk of breakage.
- In the event of defects in the electrical components, disconnect from the mains immediately and check for damage regularly.
- Avoid contact with water with electrical components.
- Do not use the product as a ladder; safety risk in case of insufficient stability.
- Avoid fire hazard: Keep the appliance away from naked flames and heat sources.
- Use the product in accordance with its intended use.
- Ground the product properly and ensure electrical safety.
- Childproofing measures are required, product is not suitable for children without supervision.
- Do not overload the cabinet to avoid structural damage.
- Caution: Risk of injury from sharp edges and corners.
- Do not unnecessarily stress or damage acrylic glass viewing windows.
- The product should only be used indoors and in dry environments.
- Carry out electrical installation in accordance with safety standards.
- Observe the maximum load capacity of the shelves (70 kg) and drawers (50 kg).
- Caution when using the electric shelf: avoid overloading, maximum 70 kg.
- Make sure that heavy objects are stored safely to avoid crushing or falling.
- Affix clearly visible warning notices on the use of the product.
- Protect the cabinet from moisture and UV damage.
