Safety Instructions:

- Make sure that the doors and drawers are properly closed to avoid injury.
- Do not exceed the maximum load: 70 kg for shelves and 50 kg for drawers.
- Make sure that the cabinet is stable to prevent it from tipping over.
- Electrical installations may only be carried out by qualified personnel in order to avoid electrical hazards.
- Keep the cabinet and electrical components away from water and moisture to avoid damage and risks.
- Only use the product in accordance with the instructions and for its intended purpose.
- Carry out regular maintenance and inspection of the product to ensure safety.
- The cabinet should always be placed on a stable, level surface.
- Use the battery and electrical components in accordance with the manufacturer's safety instructions.
- Always observe and keep the safety instructions and operating instructions.
- The electric shelf must not be loaded with more than 70 kg.
- The drawer unit must not be loaded with more than 50 kg per drawer.
- Ensure that no liquids get onto electrical components.
- The instructions supplied must be followed exactly during installation.
- The cylinder lock must be properly closed to prevent unauthorised access.
- Keep the cylinder lock keys out of the reach of children.
- The use of suitable tools is recommended for assembly.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age to avoid the risk of choking on small parts.
- Only lock the doors of the cupboard when they are closed to prevent unintentional opening.
- Cables and power supply units must be housed in a ventilated tray to prevent overheating.
- Ensure even weight distribution and observe the maximum load capacity of the shelves and drawers.
- Children should be supervised to prevent improper use.
- Ensure that all components are protected from moisture.
- Read the operating instructions in full before use.
- If the appliance is damaged, stop using it immediately and contact the manufacturer.
- Take care when handling electrical components to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- The devices should not be overloaded or used contrary to their specifications.
- Choking hazard due to small parts if handled incorrectly, therefore store safely.
- Avoid risk of electric shock if used improperly.
