Safety Instructions:

- Maximum load: 70 kg for electric shelves, 50 kg for drawers. Do not overload to avoid damage.
- Only use the socket strip if the maximum load is observed and have it installed by qualified personnel.
- Keep children and unauthorised persons away from the appliance.
- Use the product on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Ensure that the residual current circuit breaker is active and regularly checked for proper functioning to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- Ensure that electrical components, cables and sockets are regularly checked for damage.
- Only use the intended accessories (5-socket power strip) and lay all cables safely to avoid tripping hazards.
- Read instructions and observe safety precautions before use. Use only for the intended purpose.
- Do not use in damp environments to avoid damage to electronics.
- Ensure temporary safety release and maintenance for ventilation openings and temperature-controlled fan to prevent overheating.
- In the event of damage or malfunctions, disconnect the appliance from the mains immediately and consult a specialist.
- Check safety instructions regularly, especially after modifications or repairs.
- Regular maintenance of the temperature-controlled fan to prevent overheating.
- Do not use the product without fusing the residual current circuit breaker.
- Ensure disposal of the product in accordance with local regulations.
- Take care when handling small parts; not suitable for children under 3 years of age. Choking hazard.
- When opening the doors, be aware of the risk of trapping fingers and check the stability of the doors regularly.
