- Only use models and components suitable for the specified frame depth.
- Do not overload the diagonal brace to avoid structural damage.
- Watch out for dangerous situations during assembly, e.g. falling parts.
- Wear protective clothing to avoid injury during installation.
- Only use the diagonal brace for the intended load.
- The load-bearing capacity of the shelving also depends on the overall design.
- Set up securely to prevent tipping over.
- Check that all connections are tight.
- Carry out regular inspections for rust or damage.
- Design and manufacture the product in accordance with the applicable safety requirements.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions to ensure safe use.
- Only use the product for its intended purpose.
- Avoid dangers due to improper assembly in shelving systems.
- Provide safety information in understandable language.
- Manufacturer must provide evidence of documented safety checks.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for installation and use.
- Wear personal protective equipment during installation and use.
- Do not overload the product to ensure structural integrity.
- Do not use defective or corroded parts.
- Observe the maximum load capacity of the diagonal brace according to the manufacturer's specifications.
- If the diagonal brace is damaged, ensure replacement or disposal.
