

Product Safety Information

Schulte Lagertechnik steel panel level for pallet racks

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Please note the technical data of the products!

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Safety Instructions:

- Wear suitable protective equipment, e.g. gloves and safety goggles, during assembly and handling to avoid injury.
- Use suitable aids for attachment or transport to avoid injury.
- Ensure that the panels are correctly and stably mounted on the uprights to prevent them from tipping over.
- During installation, make sure that the panels are installed correctly to ensure stability.
- Regularly check the panels and their brackets for damage or wear and replace if necessary.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity: e.g. 1200, 1250, 1500, 1600, 1750, 1800, 1920, 2100, 2240, 2250, 2700, 2750, 2880, 3000, 3200, 3300, 3520, 3600, 3840 kg depending on the model.
- Ensure safe storage of the panels and even load distribution during use.
- Observe correct installation and use in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions to prevent damage and accidents.
- Ensure correct use in accordance with manufacturer's instructions, use only for intended shelving systems.
- Provide the assembly with a secure support by reaching over the uprights to prevent it from slipping.
- Distribute heavy loads evenly to prevent overloading and structural damage.
- Galvanised steel panels can have sharp edges - take care when handling.
- Observe maximum load capacity with even load distribution, e.g. 1800 kg.
- Do not use the panels as a platform or stairs to avoid the risk of falling and injury.
- Use protective clothing and suitable lifting techniques, especially when handling heavy loads.
- Regularly check the stability of the shelving structure and the panels for visible damage or corrosion.
- In case of insufficient load or improper use, there is a risk of injury from falling objects.
- Only have it installed by qualified personnel and ensure that it is mounted on a suitable surface to guarantee stability.
- If damage is detected, take immediate action to repair or replace the device.
