Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the grating is positioned correctly and securely on the shelves to prevent it from slipping or falling.
- Observe the maximum load limits to avoid structural damage or injury. Example limits: 1000 kg, 1400 kg, 1460 kg, 1780 kg, 2000 kg, 2160 kg, 2400 kg, 2640 kg, 2880 kg, 3000 kg, 3120 kg, 3600 kg, 3960 kg.
- Carry out regular inspections of the gratings for damage or wear and replace damaged parts immediately to ensure safety.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment (PPE), especially when installing or handling heavy gratings.
- Only use within the specified shelf depths and rail lengths. Ensure the correct rail depth (e.g. 50 mm) to ensure a secure fit.
- Ensure safe use of aisles and passageways to avoid accidents. Do not use gratings as walkways and keep space for passageways.
- Not suitable for use by children and keep away from small children to avoid risk of injury.
- Incorrect handling may result in injury due to high load capacity; read and follow the operating instructions carefully.
- Product not suitable for direct contact with foodstuffs, unless this is expressly intended.
- The product may only be used on level and stable surfaces to avoid the risk of tipping over.
