Safety Instructions:

- Secure chipboard properly to prevent it from slipping. Use centring plates where available.
- Only use the product for its intended purpose and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Not suitable for use in humid environments, only in dry areas (P4).
- Keep the product out of the reach of children to avoid injury.
- Do not exceed the maximum permissible load capacity: 3881 kg, 2822 kg, 2762 kg, 2346 kg, 2069 kg, 2009 kg, 1803 kg, 1706 kg, 1683 kg, 1652 kg, 1651 kg, 1378 kg, 1350 kg, 1241 kg, 1157 kg, 1100 kg, 1015 kg, 909 kg, 710 kg, 670 kg, 468 kg with evenly distributed load.
- Ensure that the chipboard is used on suitable shelving systems with the specified dimensions, such as 50 mm upright depth or greater shelf depths.
- During assembly and use, ensure that panels are correctly positioned on the uprights and securely fixed to prevent falls and instability.
- Wear personal protective equipment (gloves, safety goggles) when working to prevent injuries.
- Regularly check for damage or wear and replace damaged panels immediately.
- Ensure that the shelves are securely fastened to prevent them from tipping over or collapsing. Carry out assembly in accordance with the instructions.
- Safe transport and storage of the panels to prevent them from falling over or falling down.
