Safety Instructions:

- Do not exceed the maximum load of 250 kg per shelf to prevent tipping and structural damage.
- Mount the shelf on a stable and level surface to prevent the risk of tipping.
- Mount and secure the shelf stably, use suitable wall fixings if necessary.
- Check shelving regularly for stability, damage or wear, repair or replace if necessary.
- Use only in dry, stable indoor areas, keep away from open flames and heat sources.
- Carefully read and follow the instructions for installation and use to avoid safety risks.
- Keep small parts, such as screws, out of the reach of children, keep children away from the shelf.
- Only allow qualified persons to assemble; wear protective equipment when assembling.
- Follow the instructions for use and safety instructions, ensure that the shelf is correctly assembled before use.
- Do not use shelves as a work surface or for any use other than the intended use.
- If there are signs of damage, interrupt use and contact the manufacturer.
- Do not store any hazardous or flammable materials.
- Avoid overloading; distribute the load evenly, store heavy objects at the bottom if possible.
- Wear gloves and protective clothing when handling sharp and heavy parts.
- Use suitable aids when storing heavy objects on the upper shelves.
- Check the product regularly for signs of wear, damage, rust or structural damage.
- Ensure that the shelf is secured against tipping over.
- Protect the shelf from moisture to prevent corrosion of the metal parts.
- Ensure safe use in accordance with European safety requirements.
