Safety Instructions:

- Make sure that the partition wall is set up stably to prevent tipping and accidents.
- Regularly check the connecting elements and the stability of the movable wall, including the castors, to ensure safety.
- The partition wall is designed for indoor use and is not suitable for outdoor use.
- Avoid leaning directly against the partition wall and colliding with other objects or people to prevent damage or accidents.
- When installing the partition wall, follow the instructions carefully, take suitable protective measures and use the correct tools.
- The double castors should be locked when not in motion to prevent slipping.
- The maximum number of elements that can be connected in a row is three in order to avoid stability risks.
- The screen must not be used as a toy or in areas for children to avoid injury and must be kept out of reach of children under the age of three.
- When using in the vicinity of children, ensure that there are no sharp edges or protruding parts.
- Avoid use near heat sources, open flames and very humid environments to prevent material damage.
- The partition wall is designed exclusively for commercial indoor applications, not for use in safety areas or as a fire protection wall.
- Users should be informed of the correct procedures for using and maintaining the partition wall to ensure a long service life.
- Before use, ensure that all connecting elements are correctly and firmly tightened to ensure stability.
- Avoid using the movable wall on uneven or soft surfaces to prevent the risk of tipping.
- Regular safety inspections are necessary to ensure the functionality and safety of the partition wall.
- In the event of damage or unsafe use, take the movable wall out of operation and check it.
- Before mobile movements, keep the area around the partition free of obstacles to avoid tripping hazards.
- The maximum load capacity should be strictly adhered to.
