

# Product Safety Information

## **Rau work table Jerry, manual height adjustable, 25 mm MDF board with stainless steel coating, up to 300 kg, silver/light grey, size selection**

### **Safety Instructions:**

- Do not exceed the maximum load of 300 kg to avoid damage and tipping over.
- When adjusting the height, ensure that no parts of the body are trapped and that the adjustments are carried out safely.
- Use suitable personal protective equipment (e.g. gloves, safety goggles), especially when working with heavy parts or tools.
- Make sure that the table is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Read the operating instructions carefully before use.
- Pay attention to the stability of the table, especially with a maximum load of 300 kg.
- Risk of suffocation due to improper handling of parts - caution is advised.
- Use safe ways to adjust the height and avoid improper handling.
- Observe local safety guidelines and regulations for commercial use.
- Regularly check the stability and adjustment mechanisms.
- Do not set up the table near heat sources or damp areas.
- Only use the table in the intended area of use and secure workpieces.
- Discontinue use immediately if there are any signs of damage.
- Take care when using chemicals, oils and acids on the work surface - protective measures are required.
- Only set the working height when the appliance is not loaded.
- For manual height adjustment: Tighten the adjustment screws correctly to prevent accidents.
- Keep your workplace tidy to avoid falls and accidents.
- Recommended use of the table by one person to avoid injury.
