Safety Instructions:

- Do not exceed the maximum load of 300 kg to avoid structural damage and injury.

- Ensure that the worktable is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Only suitable for adults and young people aged 15 and over, not for children under 15.
- Make sure there are no loose parts in the vicinity to avoid injury.
- Only use the table in accordance with the instructions and for its intended purpose (e.g. assembly areas, medical facilities).
- Keep the work area free of unnecessary tools and materials to minimise tripping hazards.
- Avoid contact with water or chemical substances to prevent the risk of slipping and surface damage.
- Regular inspection for wear and damage is recommended to ensure safety.
- Ensure that all parts of the table are properly assembled and securely fastened.
- The surface of the table may be sensitive to sharp or hot objects; use protective materials to prevent damage.
- Avoid wet environments or wet hands to minimise the risk of electric shock.
