Safety Instructions:

- Only use the table within the permissible load capacity of 300 kg. Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 300 kg to avoid structural damage and injury.
- Make sure that the table is placed on a stable and level surface and ensure that it is non-slip to avoid accidents.
- Before use, ensure that the work table is stable and correctly mounted. Regularly check the stability of the work table.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment (PPE) such as safety goggles and gloves when working with sharp, hot or chemically active materials.
- Avoid working with damaged surfaces and keep the work area clear of obstacles to reduce the risk of tripping.
- Read the operating instructions carefully before starting work and follow all safety and assembly instructions.
- Keep the table away from damp conditions and water to prevent damage to the MDF board.
- Use a suitable base to ensure stability.
- Only adjust the height using the correct screws and tools and keep fingers and hands away when adjusting the working height to avoid injury.
- When adjusting the height, ensure that no body parts are trapped. Prevent injuries due to crushing hazard with adjustable table.
- The work table is not suitable for use by children; keep out of the reach of children.
- Avoid using sharp or heavy objects that could damage the surface.
- Ensure that the worktop is properly protected when working with oils, acids, chemicals and solvents.
- Choking hazard due to small parts if handled incorrectly.
