Safety Instructions:

- Please note that the table must be securely fixed when adjusting the height to prevent injuries and slipping.
- The maximum load of 500 kg must not be exceeded in order to avoid structural damage.
- Make sure that no liquids get onto the tabletop so as not to damage the melamine coating.
- The table is suitable for use in ESD-sensitive areas; ensure suitable ESD protection measures are in place.
- Avoid applying excessive force to the work surface to prolong the service life.
- Use the table on stable and level surfaces to prevent it from tipping over.
- Manual height adjustment requires special care to avoid crushing.
- Ensure that the worktable is properly assembled and stable before use.
- Choking hazard due to small parts, especially if handled incorrectly or for children under 3 years of age.
- If the chipboard is damaged, do not use the table and consider having it repaired.
- Carry out regular inspections and maintenance to ensure safety and functionality.
- To ensure safety, do not make any unauthorised modifications to the table.
- Before use, check that all parts are firmly secured and correctly fitted.
- Avoid use in humid or extremely hot environments.
- Ensure that all electrical components are properly installed and earthed.
- Keep the table free of tripping hazards and protect the surface from scratches.
