Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that all parts are correctly assembled and that the assembly instructions are followed to avoid risks.
- Read the operating instructions thoroughly before using the appliance for the first time and observe all safety instructions.
- The table should be set up on a stable, level surface and be stable to prevent it from tipping over or wobbling.
- Do not exceed the maximum load of 150 kg and ensure that the table remains stable under maximum load.
- Do not use electrical components in a damp environment and ensure that all connections are secure and dry.
- Children should only work with the product under supervision and it should be placed out of reach of children to avoid the risk of injury.
- When using the electric height adjustment, ensure that the lifting columns are clear of obstacles and that there are no objects in the way to avoid injury.
- Raised work surface should not be set above 1120 mm to prevent the table from tipping.
- Warning about electrical components: Ensure that the table is properly connected and has no visible damage.
- The table should only be operated by persons who are familiar with the electric height adjustment in order to avoid crushing injuries and the risk of falling.
- Observe safety precautions when adjusting the height and do not use the table while people are underneath it.
- Before use, ensure that the safety of the product meets the requirements.
- Avoid overloading and storing heavy or dangerous objects on the surface of the table.
- Warning: Risk of falling if the height is suddenly adjusted.
- Improper use may result in injury or damage, therefore follow the safety instructions.
