Safety Instructions:

- Observe the maximum load capacity: Do not place more than 300 kg on the table.
- Take care when using electrical height adjustment mechanisms to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- Avoid using harsh or aggressive cleaning agents on the stainless steel surface to prevent damage.
- Adjust the working height carefully to minimise the risk of injury from sudden movements of the table top.
- Ensure that the workbench is mounted in a stable and secure manner before use.
- The height-adjustable table should only be used by trained personnel.
- Make sure that there are no objects in the area of the lifting mechanism to avoid injury.
- Ensure that the electrical components are kept in a dry and clean condition to avoid short circuits.
- Do not use the product in damp or wet environments to avoid electrical hazards.
- Use only for the intended purpose to avoid accidents.
- When lifting the worktop electrically, make sure that there are no people or objects under the worktop.
- Ensure that the appliance is properly earthed to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- Ensure that the electric height adjustment is not blocked to avoid injury.
- Take care not to exceed the maximum load capacity of 300 kg.
- Avoid contact of the work surface with extremely hot materials or chemical substances to prevent damage and hazards.
- Ensure that the electrical installation complies with local safety standards.
- Do not use the workbench in damp environments, as the electrical components could be affected.
- Secure all electrical cables to avoid tripping hazards.
- The working height should be adapted to the respective activity in order to avoid ergonomic damage.
- Choking hazard due to improper use of small parts.
- Electrical connection - only to be connected by authorised specialists.
- Ensure that all cables and connections are in good condition.
- Suitable for use in dry, well-ventilated areas - not intended for outdoor use.
- Take care when handling heavy materials to avoid injury.
- Electrical installation may only be carried out by qualified personnel.
- Take care not to spill any liquids or chemicals on electrical parts.
- Do not pull or press on the electrical controls with excessive force.
- Caution! Electrical height adjustment. Disconnect from the power supply before maintenance or cleaning.
- Maintain a safe working height: Set the height between 720 mm and 1120 mm.
- Avoid collisions with fixed objects when adjusting the height.
- Suitable for use in metal construction, metalworking or soldering work.
- The product is temperature-resistant, but please note that extreme temperatures may impair its function.
