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Safety Instructions:

- Caution: Risk of injury from sharp edges and corners.
- Observe protective measures to avoid the risk of falling or falling over.
- Use suitable lifting techniques when lifting heavy elements.
- Before assembly, ensure that all parts are properly and stably assembled.
- Avoid tipping over: The workbench must be placed on a stable, flat surface to ensure stability.
- Avoid contact with openings and moving parts to prevent injury.
- Surfaces must not become overheated or damp in order to prevent damage to the linoleum tile.
- Observe the maximum load capacity of 75 kg on the shelf to prevent structural damage.
- Do not use the workbench for improper purposes such as stairs.
- Observe the manufacturer's safety instructions and maintenance guidelines.
- Ensure electrical connections to avoid electric shocks.
- Adjust the height of the workbench to ensure ergonomics and safety.
- Close the door of the workbench properly to prevent injury from unintentional opening.
- Avoid slippery materials on linoleum work surfaces to minimise the risk of falling.
- Only clean the workbench with recommended agents to prevent damage.
- Stow the workbench safely when not in use or position it stably.
- Avoid contact with sharp objects to prevent damage.
- Use sharper tools and machines with caution.
- The use of protective equipment such as gloves and safety goggles is recommended.
- Height-adjustable shelf must be safe and stable.
- Do not make the workbench accessible to children.
- Check electrical connections to avoid electric shocks.
- Careful handling of the worktop to minimise the risk of damage.
- Carry out regular inspections for damage and wear.
