Safety Instructions:

- Make sure that the drawer is securely closed during use to avoid injury.
- Make sure that the mobile pedestal is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- To prevent damage to the product, do not use a load in excess of the recommended load capacity.
- Extra care should be taken when small children are nearby to minimise the risk of injury.
- Only use the mobile pedestal on firm, level surfaces to avoid tipping.
- Ensure that no excessive load is placed on the roller container to avoid instability.
- Avoid improper assembly of the components to ensure stability.
- The smooth-running castors are not designed for outdoor use.
- Be careful when moving the mobile container when it is full to avoid injury.
- Keep the mobile pedestal away from heat sources and naked flames.
- Self-assembly of the mobile container should be carried out in accordance with the enclosed instructions in order to minimise safety risks. Read the instructions carefully before assembly and check that all parts are complete.
- Be careful with the push-to-open mechanism to avoid injuring your fingers.
- Check the castors regularly for proper functionality, strength and damage to prevent jamming.
- Do not overload the roller container to minimise the risk of instability and tipping over.
- Keep children away from the product to avoid the risk of injury. Observe child safety precautions if the product is used in the vicinity of children.
- Make sure that heavy objects are not stored in the top compartment to prevent tipping.
- The product is only suitable for indoor use. Avoid weather damage due to use in unsuitable areas.
- Take clear precautions for assembly and use to avoid any uncertainties. Defective parts must not be used. Inform the manufacturer immediately in the event of defects.
- Use in damp rooms can damage the material, select a suitable location.
