Safety Instructions:

- There is a risk of injury from sharp edges of the glass if handled incorrectly. The product must be checked for possible sharp edges before assembly.
- Make sure that the sideboard is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over, especially if children are nearby.
- The sideboard should be fixed to a wall and the use of products in the vicinity of children should always be supervised, as the drawers and doors pose a crushing hazard.
- Avoid using chemical and aggressive cleaning agents on the surfaces and the glass surface to prevent damage to the coating and the glass surface. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents when cleaning to avoid damaging the surface.
- Keep the doors and drawers closed to reduce the risk of injury and ensure that they are not overloaded (maximum load 10 kg per drawer).
- The maximum load on the drawers and shelves must not be exceeded (drawers up to 10 kg, top shelf up to 30 kg, bottom shelf up to 15 kg).
- The product should not be installed near heat sources to avoid the risk of fire.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the top shelf when the sideboard is against a wall to prevent it from tipping over.
- Safety distances must be maintained to avoid shocks and impacts that could affect the stability of the furniture.
- Before installation, all individual parts should be checked for damage and installation should be carried out by a qualified person.
- Use suitable furniture glides to prevent damage to the floor.
- Keep sharp or pointed objects away from the edges and corners of the furniture to avoid injury.
- Check the stability of the furniture regularly to avoid the risk of falling.
- Keep small parts away from children to minimise the risk of swallowing.
- The surfaces are scratch-resistant, but check regularly for damage to avoid safety risks.
