Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the tray is placed on a stable and level surface to avoid the risk of tipping.
- Check the tray regularly for leaks and damage and replace damaged parts immediately.
- Avoid overloading. Observe the maximum load capacity to avoid structural damage.
- Protect the tub from extreme weather conditions, UV radiation and sharp objects to prevent material damage.
- Observe chemical resistance: Only use suitable chemicals in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions in order to avoid reactions and damage to the material of the tray.
- Carry out regular inspections of the seals to ensure tightness.
- Label the sump with warnings and ensure that the emergency procedures in the event of chemical leaks are known.
- Use appropriate personal protective equipment to avoid skin contact with chemicals.
- Products are intended for professional use; beware of potential risks from improper use.
- Avoid use in pedestrian areas to minimise the risk of injury.
- Ensure that the leakage tray is stored in a dry, stable place when not in use.
- Proper access to the tub must be ensured in order to avoid safety-related barriers or obstacles.
- Follow the instructions for safe use and regular maintenance of the tray and observe the chemical compatibility of the product.
- In the event of chemical leaks or damage, take appropriate protective measures immediately and follow emergency procedures.
