Safety Instructions:

- Not suitable for eating. Keep away from children.
- Never cut or handle with sharp objects.
- If used incorrectly, the laminating film may tear or come loose. If used incorrectly, there is a possible risk of injury from sharp edges of the film. If used incorrectly, the adhesive layer can be damaged by high temperatures.
- Ensure appropriate storage and use in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. All manufacturer's instructions should be carefully read and followed before use.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years due to small parts. Caution: Not suitable for children. Small parts could pose a choking hazard. Keep out of reach of children to avoid choking hazard due to possible choking parts. Product not suitable for use by children under 3 years of age as there is a risk of the foils being accidentally swallowed.
- Keep away from heat sources and direct sunlight. Avoid contact with moisture. Avoid direct sunlight and store the films at room temperature to ensure optimum shelf life. Do not use near heat sources.
- Only use in conjunction with compatible laminators. Only use films with suitable hot laminators to avoid the risk of overheating and fire.
- In the event of contact with food, only use materials that are suitable for food contact in accordance with the applicable regulations. The laminating films are not suitable for direct contact with food. The films must not come into direct contact with food.
- Please follow the instructions for safe use and disposal. Dispose of the laminating films in accordance with the local regulations for plastic waste.
- The rounded corners ensure safe handling and prevent cuts.
- May melt if handled improperly or overheated; therefore, follow the device instructions when laminating. Avoid overheating during lamination so as not to jeopardise the films.
- The laminating film is only suitable for the intended use. Do not use damaged films.
