Safety Instructions:

- Set up securely to prevent tipping over. Ensure that the cabinet is stable and mounted on a flat, stable surface; secure to the wall if necessary.
- Only use the locks and brackets provided to avoid injury. Use the clothes rail and sliding hooks in accordance with the instructions to avoid injury. The use of a locking system prevents unauthorised access to personal items.
- Contact the manufacturer in the event of faults. Contact the manufacturer if you have any questions or problems.
- Suitable for use in schools and nurseries. Product is suitable for use by children, but use by children should be supervised. Not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to small parts.
- Watch out for sharp edges or points during assembly and use. Warning of sharp edges: Protruding parts could cause injuries.
- Carry out regular inspections for damage or wear and tear. Regularly check the locks, doors, door recesses and hinges for functionality and security.
- Keep the cabinet away from sources of fire, direct sunlight, moisture and water to minimise the risk of fire and corrosion damage.
- Use security locks and rotary cylinder locks to store personal items securely and prevent unauthorised access.
- Assembly should be carried out by specialised personnel. The instructions must be followed exactly during assembly to ensure stability and safety.
- Do not overload, do not store heavy objects beyond recommended limits to prevent tipping and structural damage.
- Vandal-proof doors: Stable and curved forwards, robust against damage caused by forced opening. Suitable for high-traffic environments such as schools and nurseries.
- Do not bring sharp objects near the doors, close the doors gently to avoid damage and crushing.
- Packaging and transport must be carried out safely to avoid damage. Transport furniture carefully, heavy parts can cause injury.
- Prevent children from climbing near the cabinet or pulling themselves up on it. Encourage appropriate use of the cabinet doors to prevent mechanical damage.
- Dispose of the cabinet in a fair and environmentally friendly manner to avoid potential environmental risks.
- Stability and safety are guaranteed by the high-quality steel construction and baked-on coating.
- Regular maintenance and inspection of the stop dampers to prevent injuries caused by overstretched doors.
