Safety Instructions:

- Before use, ensure that the cabinet is standing on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Be careful when accessing the upper shelves to prevent slipping or falling.
- Close the doors completely to prevent accidental opening and ensure that there is sufficient space to prevent injuries caused by sudden movements (max. opening angle 110°).
- Children should be kept away from the cupboard to avoid accidents or injuries.
- Note load capacities: Max. load capacity of the cupboard 450 kg, max. load capacity per shelf 250 kg or according to manufacturer's specifications. Ensure even weight distribution on the shelves.
- When installing and inserting the shelves, make sure that they are securely engaged and fixed in the intended grid to prevent them from falling out (usually 25-26.5 mm grid).
- Use the cylinder lock regularly and check that it is working properly to prevent unauthorised access to the contents. Ensure key security.
- Do not block ventilation holes to ensure sufficient air circulation and to prevent moisture damage or mould growth.
- To minimise safety risks, do not overload the product or fill it with non-intended hazardous materials.
- Check the cabinet regularly for damage and the functionality of the locking mechanisms. Contact the manufacturer in the event of damage.
- When installing, ensure that the floor is levelled (25 mm for uneven floors) to prevent tilting.
- Follow the instructions in the operating instructions to ensure safe use of the product.
- The product is not suitable for use by children due to potential hazards from opening and closing the doors and the weight of the contents.
- Keep the cabinet dry and out of direct sunlight to preserve the integrity of the material.
- The cabinet should not be used for unauthorised climbing or supporting to avoid the risk of falling.
- Always ensure that the cabinet is placed on a non-slip surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Avoid overloading the compartments to ensure stability and safety in use.
- Ensure that the product fulfils all international and national safety standards as well as operating instructions in an understandable language.
