Safety Instructions:

- Risk of suffocation due to improper use or careless handling of small parts such as cylinder locks and screws.
- Risk of injury due to improper opening of the doors; observe the soft stop and door opening limiter. The door opens to a maximum of 90 degrees.
- Sharp edges or corners can cause injuries; therefore ensure that sharp edges are covered during installation.
- Ensure stability, especially on uneven ground, to avoid tipping over; use levelling device.
- Avoid use by children without supervision to minimise the risk of injury.
- Secure use: Ensure that you use suitable locks (e.g. security twist locks with padlocks with a shackle thickness of 6-8 mm) to prevent theft.
- Regularly check for corrosion and damage to minimise safety risks.
- Keep ventilation openings clear and keep the locker dry to avoid corrosion and moisture problems.
- Transport and storage protection required to minimise the risk of corrosion or damage.
- Make sure that the locker is always set up in a stable position to prevent it from tipping over.
- Ensure that the product is kept away from children if it is not suitable for their use.
- Avoid overstretching the doors; the door opens to a maximum of 90 degrees.
- Make sure that the locker is placed on a stable and level floor to prevent it from tipping over.
- Keep the locker clean and dry to prevent corrosion and other damage.
- Include safety and care instructions to ensure the safety of the consumer.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the locker to minimise stability risks.
