Safety Instructions:

- Observe the load capacity specifications for the clothes locker: Max. Check the maximum load regularly to avoid overloading and structural damage.
- The clothes locker is heavy (weight: 58.40 kg). Ensure safe handling during transport and assembly.
- Avoid danger due to improper use of small parts or due to accessibility for small children; not suitable for children under 3 years of age.
- Avoid the risk of suffocation from small parts or when opening the compartments.
- Risk of injury due to sharp edges or corners; caution required during handling and assembly.
- Risk of injury when closing the doors; use soft stop to minimise damage and avoid overstretching.
- Use the door opening limiter to prevent the doors from overstretching; do not open the doors more than 90 degrees.
- Ensure that the locker is stable and on a level surface to prevent it from tipping over. Use the levelling feet.
- For the safety of children, place the locker out of their reach; use by children should be supervised.
- Do not block ventilation openings; ensure adequate ventilation to prevent moisture build-up and odours.
- Read the instructions carefully before using the product and observe the safety information.
- Burglar-proof construction available, but only store valuable items if necessary and with recommended locks.
- The clothes locker should not be placed near heat sources or in damp environments to prevent damage.
- Make sure that no heavy objects are placed on the cabinet to prevent it from tipping over.
- Regular maintenance and inspection to ensure stability, especially on uneven floors thanks to levelling.
- Before use, ensure that the clothes locker is stable and securely installed and check regularly for damage.
- When opening the doors, make sure that there are no people or objects in the opening area to avoid injury.
- When using cylinder locks or safety twist locks, follow the manufacturer's instructions to avoid injury.
- Clean with suitable, non-abrasive products so as not to damage the coating.
- Use only in dry indoor areas and not near water sources.
- Adults should supervise use by children.
