Safety Instructions:

- Wear safety goggles and gloves when drilling to avoid injury.

- Hold the workpiece firmly in place to prevent it from slipping during the drilling process.
- Keep the work area clean and free of obstacles and hazards.
- After use, store the drill in a safe, dry place and out of the reach of children.
- Only use under adult supervision as the drill is not suitable for children.
- Use suitable machines to prevent overheating of the drill and accidents.
- Do not use in the vicinity of flammable materials to avoid the risk of fire.
- Ensure that the drill bit is not overloaded or overtightened to prevent material damage.
- Read the operating instructions and safety precautions before use.
- Observe protective measures to avoid injuries from flying chips and sharp edges.
- Store in a childproof place to minimise the risk of choking on small parts.
- Replace damaged or worn drill bits immediately to ensure safety.
