

# Product Safety Information

## RUKO core drill

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Please note the technical data of the products!

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## Safety Instructions:

- Before use, always wear personal protective equipment consisting of safety goggles, gloves and, if necessary, hearing protection.
- Ensure that the drill bit is correctly mounted in the drill to prevent it from slipping during use.
- Always disconnect the appliance from the power supply before maintenance, cleaning or changing the drill bit.
- The work area must be kept clean and free of obstacles and out of the reach of children.
- Do not touch the drill during operation and keep body parts away from the cutting edge.
- If the drill bit overheats, stop operation immediately and allow it to cool down.
- Only use the drill with suitable machines and follow the manufacturer's safety and operating instructions.
- Check drill bits regularly for wear or damage and replace if necessary.
- Only adults or trained professionals should use the drill.
- Avoid using the drill bit on unstable or uneven materials that could cause injury.
- Do not use in the vicinity of flammable materials and ensure that the working environment is well ventilated.
- Child safety: Store product safely and out of reach of children.
- The manufacturer's safety and handling instructions should be read before use.
