Safety Instructions:

- Set up securely to prevent tipping and injury; place on a stable and level surface to prevent tipping or falling.
- Do not open if it is overheated or smoke is developing.
- Store securely to prevent theft and unauthorised access; observe the instructions for operating the electronic lock and follow the operating instructions for the electronic lock.
- Regularly check the safety features; regularly check for fire and water damage.
- Follow fire prevention instructions; beware of flammable materials stored near the safe.
- Ensure that the safe is properly installed and secured; increased risk if the safe is improperly anchored, especially if the weight is less than 1000 kg.
- The safety instructions and operating instructions must be carefully observed.
- Keep out of reach of children to prevent injury or improper use; do not make the product accessible to children.
- In the event of danger or irregularities, inform the responsible authorities immediately.
- Take care when using near water vapour or other liquids to avoid electrical risks.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment when handling the safe, especially if it is heavy; note: safe can be heavy and should be securely fastened to prevent accidents.
- Take care when handling electronic components; set up and operate the safe in accordance with the enclosed instructions; risk of suffocation if electronic components are handled incorrectly.
- The fire protection of the safe offers a protection period of 30 minutes for paper only; fire protection in accordance with LFS 30P, 30 minutes for paper in accordance with EN 15659 BG - do not store any fire loads in the safe in the event of fire.
- Take care when opening the safe to avoid injury from heavy doors.
- Avoid moisture to prevent damage to the contents; storage in dry, temperature-controlled rooms recommended - prevents damage from moisture.
- Product has safety class 1 according to PN-EN 1143-1:2012 IMP - use only for the intended purpose.
- Include instructions for use and safety information in easy-to-understand language.
- Ensure that the product complies with the general safety requirements; regularly check that the product complies with the technical documentation.
- Take immediate corrective action in the event of a safety risk.
- Risk of collision due to improper placement or use of the safe.
- Warning of high temperatures, especially when setting up near fireplaces.
- Lock with double-bit lock - the manufacturer must be informed immediately if the key is lost.
