Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the workbench is standing on a level, stable surface and is securely fastened to the floor to prevent it from wobbling or tipping over.
- The maximum load capacity of 750 kg must not be exceeded.
- Do not load the drawer above the maximum load of 80 kg to prevent damage.
- Stow heavy objects securely and evenly in the cupboard and drawer to prevent them from tipping over.
- Before use, ensure that all drawers and doors are properly closed.
- Only use the workbench for its intended purpose, do not use it as a ladder or seat.
- When handling sharp tools and materials, wear personal protective equipment to avoid injury.
- Check the workbench regularly for stability, damage and signs of wear and replace defective parts immediately.
- Avoid contact with aggressive chemicals and protect the workbench from moisture to prevent material damage.
- The workbench is not suitable for children and should be placed out of reach.
- When used in ESD-sensitive areas, observe ESD protection measures.
- Use of the combination workbench by trained personnel is recommended, especially when using heavy or sharp tools.
- Keep the work area clean and free of obstacles to avoid tripping hazards.
- Carry out regular safety checks and ensure that all components are working properly.
