

Product Safety Information

Box workbench Schäfer Shop Select PWi 150-6, beech multiplex board or medium density fiberboard, up to 750 kg, W 1500 mm, color selection

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Please note the technical data of the products!

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Safety Instructions:

- The workbench may only be used by adults and should be placed out of the reach of children to avoid injury.
- When using the workbench, the maximum load limits of 750 kg must not be exceeded in order to avoid structural damage.
- The drawers should not be loaded above a maximum load of 80 kg to prevent damage or injury due to overloading.
- Regular checks of the stability and functionality of the workbench and drawer units are recommended to ensure safety.
- Avoid contact with water or other liquids to prevent damage to the MDF surface and electric shocks.
- Keep the work area free of excessive loads and obstacles to minimise the risk of tripping and to ensure the stability of the workbench.
- The use of suitable personal protective equipment is recommended to prevent injuries during work.
- Ensure that the workbench is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over or wobbling.
- The workbench should not be used improperly, as this can lead to injury or damage.
- Do not use the drawers for sitting or standing to avoid injury from tipping over.
- Ensure that the workbench is stable under maximum load.
- The drawers should be secured with a lock to prevent unauthorised access.
- Store small parts and tools neatly, as they could pose a risk of suffocation or injury.
- The workbench is not suitable for outdoor use, as moisture or sunlight can damage the materials.
