Safety Instructions:

- Observe the maximum load capacity of 750 kg to ensure stability and safety. Overloading can lead to structural damage.
- The drawers are designed for a maximum load of 80 kg. Avoid overloading to prevent damage and instability.
- Shelves must not exceed a maximum load of 50 kg. Careful handling is required to avoid tipping or dropping.
- Place the workbench stably on a level and firm surface to prevent it from tipping or falling over.
- The workbench must be securely fastened to the floor to prevent it from tipping over, especially in commercial use.
- Observe ESD-compliant design. Ensure protection against electrostatic discharge in sensitive areas.
- The workbench is not permanently suitable for contact with water. Avoid corrosion caused by contact with water.
- Take precautions against sharp edges and corners to avoid injury.
- Choking hazard: Use the workbench and storage elements properly to avoid accidents.
- Stow sharp objects safely to prevent cuts.
- Avoid contact with aggressive chemicals and excessive temperatures to prevent material damage.
- Read the assembly instructions carefully and ensure that all parts are correctly assembled.
- Do not allow children to use the product and keep them away to avoid the risk of injury.
- For safety reasons, use suitable devices when lifting or moving the workbench.
- Use the integrated cylinder lock to prevent unauthorised access. Keep the key safe.
- Ensure that all drawers and doors are properly closed to prevent injuries caused by sudden opening.
- Regularly check for loose parts or damage and carry out any necessary repairs immediately.
- To ensure the proper functioning and safety of the drawers and compartments, do not allow them to offer any resistance after closing.
- Ensure free access to all work areas to prevent tripping hazards.
- Only use the workbench for its intended purpose and observe the appropriate regulations for the use of materials.
- Wear safety goggles when handling heavy materials to avoid injury.
- Ensure safe handling and the correct weight to minimise the risk of injury.
- Consult the operating instructions in full to ensure safe operation of the workbench.
- The workbench should not be used as a climbing aid or to support people.
