Safety Instructions:

- Be aware of the risk of injury from sharp edges or corners of the workbench.

- In the event of damage, take the workbench out of operation and contact the manufacturer.
- Keep the work surface free of liquids and chemical substances that could damage the surface.
- Keep children and unauthorised access away to avoid injury.
