

# Product Safety Information

## Box workbench Schäfer Shop Select PWi 300-0, beech multiplex board or medium density fiberboard, up to 750 kg, W 3000 mm, color selection

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Please note the technical data of the products!

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### Safety Instructions:

- Risk of suffocation due to improper handling or storage of heavy objects and small parts that are not suitable for children.
- Risk of electric shock due to improper contact with electrical components; observe ESD protection measures.
- Risk of injury from sharp edges or moving parts of drawers and tools; wear protective clothing.
- Danger due to unstable construction if not assembled correctly; workbench should be fixed stably and securely to the floor.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 750 kg to avoid overturning or structural damage.
- Do not overfill the drawers; maximum load per drawer 80 kg and per shelf 50 kg.
- Store heavy objects securely and ensure that they are not placed on drawers and compartments weighing more than 50 kg.
- To protect the surface coating, the workbench must not be exposed to direct heat or chemicals.
- Make sure that the product is inaccessible to children to avoid the risk of injury.
- Keep the work surface clean and free of slippery substances to prevent falls.
- Use only for its intended purpose; do not use improperly to avoid injury.
- Carry out regular stability and mechanical checks to ensure safety during use.
- Follow the installation instructions carefully to ensure that all parts are installed correctly.
- Check the locks and hinges of the drawers regularly to ensure that they function properly and are secure.
- Use protective equipment such as gloves and safety goggles, especially when used in workshops.
