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Safety Instructions:

- The mobile workbench should not be used as a work surface for hazardous chemicals without suitable safety precautions.
- Ensure that the workbench is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Do not exceed the maximum load of 400 kg to avoid structural damage.
- Do not overload the drawer; observe the maximum load capacity of 80 kg.
- Shelves may be loaded with a maximum of 50 kg per shelf.
- Apply the parking brake on the swivel castors to prevent unintentional rolling away.
- Keep the surrounding area free of obstacles and tripping hazards, especially when using swivel castors.
- Observe electrical safety measures to minimise the risk of electric shock, especially when used near water.
- Wear personal protective equipment such as gloves, especially when working with sharp or heavy tools.
- Maintain the workbench regularly for mechanical and electrical safety, including checking the rubber wheels and the cylinder lock.
- Keep children away to avoid injury from sharp edges or improper use.
- When moving the workbench, ensure that all components are secured and the brakes are activated to prevent accidents.
- Read the safety information and the operating manual thoroughly before using the device for the first time.
- The mobile workbench is intended for adults only; children should not have access.
- Keep heavy tools safely in the drawer to prevent potential hazards when opening.
- Use suitable ESD protection when handling sensitive electronic components.
- Avoid the risk of slipping due to wet floors by ensuring that the workbench is secure and stable.
- Regularly check that the telescopic runners are undamaged to ensure safe drawer operation.
- Avoid pressing body parts together when closing the drawer to minimise the risk of crushing.
